



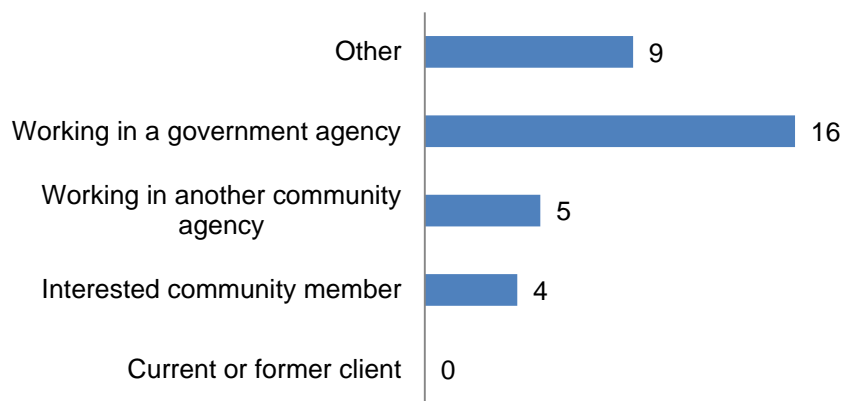

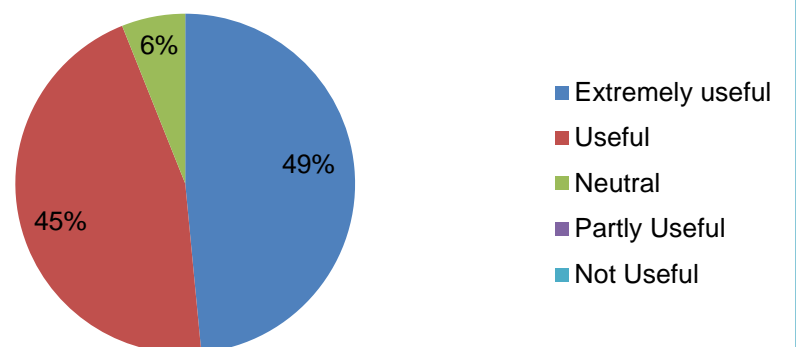

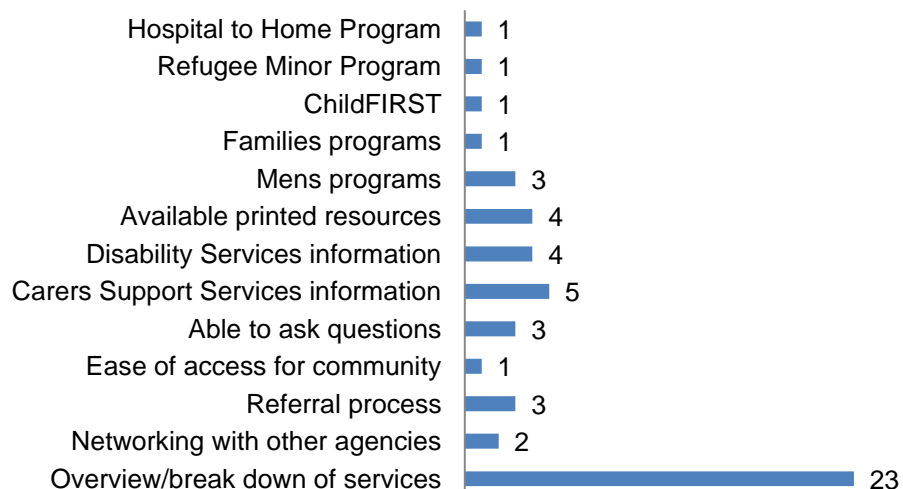
What category best describes you?



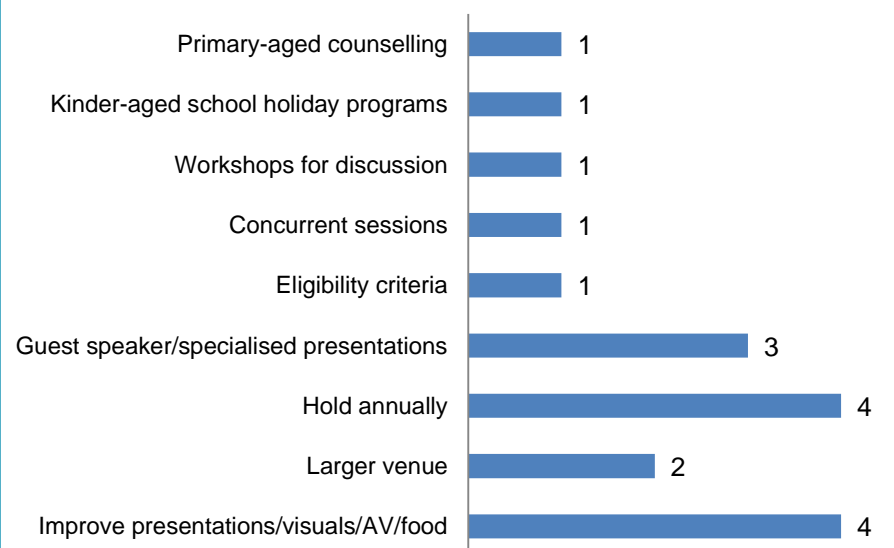
