

Medication

If your young person will require medication while attending an activity, current medication information and signed consent in the Participant Care Plan is legally required.

All medication must be handed to program staff in a MED PAK. Med Pak's can be made up with the person's medication at all pharmacies.

PLEASE NOTE: If the medication given to staff does not match information contained in the Care Plan, then staff are unable to assist with that person's medication.

If your young person is only requiring medication short term EG: Antibiotics, hayfever medication etc, please speak to the program staff to organise a Medication consent form

NDIS Participant Information

IntoRec programs are designed to involve people with a disability in the mainstream community through a range of socially inclusive community based activities.

However, the NDIA is unable to fund the cost of some activities on IntoRec programs because they are not disability specific. These activities are considered an expense that anyone choosing this activity, would have to pay for.

To be able to continue to provide community based activities, IntoRec is asking for NDIS participants to pay the cost of the activity itself. If participants chose not to pay, a similarly themed centre-based activity will be provided.

The NDIA will fund recreation supports that are related to the participant's disability, not expenses that are ordinarily funded from a person's income. For example, the NDIA may fund a specialised aid or piece of equipment that may assist the person to participate in a recreational activity.
